DISPOSITION: The Board entered into a Consent Order with Respondent, in which he pled guilty to violations of Ala. Code § 34-4-20 (1975 as amended), for conducting auctions for the sale of items to the general public, including the calling for and receiving of bids on items of general merchandise without having first obtained an auctioneer license and/or an auction company license from the Board. Respondent was assessed an administrative fine of \$400.00 for these violations.

Disposition: The Board entered into a Consent Order with Respondents, in which they pled guilty to violations of ALA. Code § 34-4-20 (1975 as amended), for purchasing miscellaneous items for sale to the general public by means of public auction, advertising public auctions for the sale of such items and conducting weekly auctions for the sale of such items to the general public without having first obtained an auctioneer license and/or an auction company license from the Board. Respondents were assessed an administrative fine of \$3,000.00 for these violations.
