150-X-1-.02 (j) Application for Auctioneer's License Inactive Status

An Auctioneer or Apprentice Auctioneer may elect an inactive status certification by notifying the Board in writing or by completing this form. The notification must be received by the Board at least thirty (30) days before the license is due to expire. Only active license may elect inactive status; an expired license is not eligible for an inactive statues certificate. To qualify for inactive status, a licensee must not be actively engaged in auctioneering or any auctioneer activity requiring an auctioneer or apprentice auctioneer license. The fee for the issuance of an inactive status <u>Auctioneer \$100.00</u> / Apprentice Auctioneer: \$50.00 Cashier's Check, Money Order, Personal Check or Business Check. <u>NO CASH!</u>

To reinstate an inactive certificate to an active license, the licensee must pay the appropriate renewal fee and provide proof of satisfactory completion of seven (6) hours of approved continuing education for each year of inactive status.
